

## **RAYBA - Parent/Guardian Code Of Conduct**

All parents/guardians and players are expected to conduct themselves appropriately at all team functions and abide by the following rules and guidelines:

### **Parents/Guardians**

I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support in both verbal comments and actions for all players, coaches, and officials at every game, practice, or other related youth sports event.

I will treat and ask my child to treat all players, coaches, and officials with dignity, honesty, and respect in language, attitude, behavior, and mannerisms regardless of race, creed, sex, or ability. I will remember that the game is for youth, not adults. I will do my very best to make youth sports fun for my child and other team members.

I will place the emotional and physical well being of my child ahead of my personal desire to win through my words and actions.

I will insist that my child play in a safe and healthy environment.

I will require that my child's coach uphold the Coach's Code of Conduct.

I will respect the property and equipment used at any sports facility, both home and away.

I will inform the coach of any physical disability or ailment that may affect the safety of my athlete or the safety of others.

I will see that my child attends scheduled practices. If my child is late or absent without excuse, they will be subject extra conditioning and/or loss of playing time.

I will have open communication with my child's coaches. I will not speak with them about my concerns during and directly following games.

Parents/Guardians agree that if I fail to abide by the aforementioned rules and guidelines, the parent/guardian may be subject to disciplinary action. Including but not limited to the following:

## **RAYBA - Coach Code Of Conduct**

All coaches are expected to conduct themselves appropriately at all team functions and abide by the following rules and guidelines:

### **Coaches**

I will place the emotional and physical well being of my players ahead of my personal desire to win through my words and actions.

I will treat each player as an individual, remembering the large range of emotional and physical development for the same age group.

I will do my best to provide a safe playing situation for my players.

I will do my best to provide a planned, organized, and challenging practice environment for my players.

I will lead by example in demonstrating fair play, respect, and sportsmanship to all my players, officials, and opponents

I will become knowledgeable in the rules of the sport and will teach these rules to my players.

I will use those coaching techniques appropriate for all of the skills that I teach.

I will continually revisit the fact that I am a youth sports coach, and that the game is for children and not for adults.

I will accept communication responsibilities both written and verbal to and from the association and to/from the player and his family.

Coaches agree that if I fail to abide by the aforementioned rules and guidelines, the coach may be subject to disciplinary action. Including but not limited to the following:
